- Every Individual Runner in the 2K is encouraged to complete a Sponsorship Form in addition to the entry donation. Please hand in to the Registration Desk between 1000 and 1055.
- Sponsorship Forms must be collected immediately after the run from the Registration Desk
- Sponsorship Money should preferably be handed in with the Sponsorship Form(s) (or contactless payment) at the Registration Desk on the day in a sealed envelope. (Cheques payable to Lions Club of Dorchester and District) Alternatively cheques with Sponsorship Form(s) can be sent to Lion Treasurer Neil Gatehouse as above
- Sponsorship sums submitted by Individual Runners of less than £20 will be retained by the Dorchester and District Lions Club for the Lions' Local Charity Fund.

ROUTE – Runners will complete 2 clockwise circuits of the Pathways between the Pavillion, the Cemetery entrance returning to the Pavillion.

SAFETY

Runners should keep to the left except when overtaking. Whilst every effort is made to supervise the routes for maximum safety, The Lions Club of Dorchester & District, Marshals and Sponsors accept no responsibility for any accident that might occur, however caused, or loss of valuables and kit. The use of bicycles, roller skates, roller blades, scooters, skateboards etc is NOT permitted. **However we welcome toddlers under 4 in pushchairs and wheelchair users.** In accordance with England Athletics regulations the use of headphones is not allowed in the race.

Route Marshals will be in place at key locations to guide runners on the route, provide encouragement and give assistance as required.
